For inpatient, residential and facility-based services

Make the most of your benefits by using an Optum Substance Use Disorder Preferred Provider.

When you use an Optum® SUD Preferred Provider for inpatient, residential or facility-based services such as intensive outpatient treatment, your costs will be waived as part of your State of Tennessee behavioral health benefits. PPO members who use these high-quality facilities will not pay a deductible or coinsurance. CDHP/HSA members' coinsurance will be waived after meeting their deductible.

Prior authorization is required for in-network and out-of-network services. If a prior authorization is not received, claims for services may be denied for reimbursement.

This should be done by a substance use treatment professional before you enter any treatment program.

In many cases, the most appropriate treatment does not necessarily mean being admitted into a facility. Many clinical advancements have been made in treating addiction. These include medication-assisted treatment with behavioral support services and counseling. However, each person is unique, so it is important that you have a treatment plan that is designed specifically for you.
